

**CORNWALL COUNTY A.S.A.**  
**JUNIOR INTER CLUB COMPETITION**  
**RULES & CONDITIONS**

1. Cornwall County ASA shall be the promoting body for the competition.
2. Any Club participating in the competition shall be affiliated to CCASA
3. The competition will take place at a venue and date fixed by the Swimming Committee.
4. The competition will consist of TWO DIVISIONS comprising of a maximum of six teams in each division. If more than twelve teams wish to enter the competition a waiting list will be formed.  
Only one team per Club may enter
5. Each year there will be promotion and relegation with the bottom TWO teams in Division One going down to Division Two and the top TWO teams in Division Two going up to Division One.
6. The winning team in Division One will receive the Junior Inter Club Shield and the winning team in Division Two will receive the Julie Search Shield . The competitors of the top three teams in both Divisions will each receive awards.
7. Any team who enters the competition then withdraws without good reason could be liable to a fine of £100.
8. Swimmers participating in the competition shall have joined the Club they represent at least 60 days before the start of the competition. Should a swimmer be a member of more than one Club taking part in the competition the Club with their longest unbroken membership shall have precedence on the swimmer.
9. Only swimmers who are eligible for this years Cornwall County Championships/Age Groups are allowed to take part in this competition.
10. Any swimmer taking part in this competition for one Club are ineligible to compete for any other Club in the Cornwall County Championships/Age Groups in the current year.
11. Programme of events attached.
12. Swimmers in the 9 years, 10 years and 11 years events may only compete in three individual events of which at least one and not more than two must be in their own age group. 12 year old swimmers may only compete in two individual events in their own age group.  
There are no restriction on the number of relays a swimmer may compete in.  
**ANY CLUB FOUND CONTRAVENING THIS RULE WILL FORFEIT THE NUMBER OF POINTS IN ALL THE EVENTS IN WHICH A SWIMMER HAS CONTRAVENED THE RULES. THE OTHER CLUBS POINTS WILL BE ADJUSTED ACCORDINGLY.**
13. Ages will be on the day of the competition.
14. All 9 year old swimmers must of reached the age of 9 years on the day of the competition.
15. Division points will be awarded according to the number of teams in the gala i.e. six teams 6,5,4,3,2,1, or 5 teams 5,4,3,2,1, etc.  
In the event of a tie for total division points a count back on the number of first places will

decide the positions.

16. A draw for Lanes will be made prior to the day of the competition.

Teams are to hand in TEAM SHEETS before the competition commences.

17. CCASA will appoint the Senior Officials for the gala.

18. Competing Clubs must appoint ONE JUDGE and at least ONE TIMEKEEPER for the competition.

19. Anything not covered in the above Rules and Conditions or in CCASA General Competition Rules shall be dealt with by the Swimming Committee

Further notes:

ÿ Swimmers in the 9 years, 10 years and 11 years events may only compete in three individual events which at least one and not more than two must be in their own age group. 12 year old swimmers may only compete in two individual events in their own age group. There are no restrictions on the number of relays a swimmer may compete in.

ÿ All 9 year old swimmers must have reached the age of 9 years on the day of the gala.

ÿ In the 9 years Mixed Relay events there will be two girls and two boys to swim in any order.

ÿ In the 8 x 50m. Freestyle events there will be two swimmers from each age group, swimming in ascending order.
